**Annual Swim Fees**

Fees are an annual amount per swimmer determined by each swimmer's group placement

Fees may be paid annually in one lump sum or in 3 equal installments

These groups also pay an annual registration fee of \$75 to cover USA Swimming registration and insurance and Pilot registration

A sibling discount of 30% of the least expensive swimmer's fee is offered for the 3rd child or more in one family

**Annual Fundraising Requirement**

Your annual fundraising obligation is \$400 per family with \$200 due 1/15/10 and \$200 due 5/15/10

You have 3 options for satisfying your annual fundraising obligation:

- Option 1 -** You may pay your fundraising obligation directly during the year.
- Option 2 -** You may sell advertising in the heat sheets sold for each of the home meets that Pilot hosts. The amount of the ads sold offset your fundraising dollar for dollar. For example, if you sell a \$300 ad to your dentist, then \$300 is applied as a credit against your annual fundraising obligation.
- Option 3 -** You may purchase grocery or other retailer scrip gift certificates and earn various fundraising amounts to be applied as credits against your annual fundraising obligation. (See grocery and scrip information attached.)

**Swim Meets Hosted by Pilot**

Pilot is a parent volunteer club. Pilot hosts several swim meets during the year as fundraisers to help defray the operating costs of the club. Each hosted meet requires the staffing of numerous volunteer positions which enables the meet to run smoothly. Pilot can not afford to hire workers to staff these meets. Pilot needs your commitment to staff these meets.

**ESCROW ACCOUNT:** Funds in the escrow account are used to pay entry fees and miscellaneous items (e.g. swim caps, championship shirts) for your swimmer(s) at the various meets we attend throughout the year. Each family places \$75 (enough to cover 1 to 2 meets) per swimmer on deposit with our Meet Secretary at the beginning of the year. Additional monies must be deposited to maintain the \$75 balance as needed. The Meet Secretary will notify you when additional funds are needed via email and website.

First payment to escrow is due on September 14, 2009. *This escrow account is totally separate from and unrelated to any dues and fundraising monies.*
